**Students may also be referred for an interview by a member of the Senior Leadership Team, Progress Leader or Director of Learning.**

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## How 1-2-1 CEIAG interviews support our students

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*Careers guidance interviews are aimed at supporting students in making decisions about their future.*

### *This can include:*

- + Career goals and exploring wider options*
- + 6th form, college and apprenticeship information*
- + Support with choices and application forms*
- + Discussion around strengths and matching suitable careers*
- + Use of online programmes to support learners in researching information on careers*
- + Questionnaires to help learners to identify what they might be interested in*
- + Advice on work experience and volunteering*
- + Advice on gaining part time work*
- + Completion of an action plan to identify their next steps*
- + Information on specific careers of their choice*
- + Raising aspirations and looking at positive actions around revision and aiming higher*
- + Support with any concerns that learners may have, through mentoring*
- + Helping learners to contact employers or education providers*
