Dear Parents/Carers

Unfortunately, recently we have wasted time dealing with a minority of students who have ignored the rules. We have gone through some reminders with students today and will expect all students to be properly dressed and presented ready for learning next half term. Please note the following points:-

- Trousers – not leggings, skinny trousers or jeans
- Skirts – not lycra, elastacine, tight fitting or short
- Belts – plain black with small buckles
- Make-up/false eyelashes/heavily penciled eyebrows/false nails/nail varnish should not be worn
- Jewellery – one small ring allowed. No bracelets/necklaces
- Piercings – only one small stud earring in each earlobe
- Plain black shoes – not trainers
- No extreme hairbands/scarves

If students refuse to cooperate, they will be placed in isolation and you will be contacted.
